Setting Up Your Phone Prior to use it is necessary to install both the battery and SIM into their corresponding internal compartments. Keep all SIM cards out of reach of small children. Carefully slide the SIM card into the SIM card socket as shown until the card locks into place. The Travel Charger that is used to charge the battery, is included with your phone. Use only Samsungapproved batteries and chargers. Note Long backlight settings, searching for service, vibrate mode, browser use, and other variables may reduce the battery's talk and standby. Tap one of the application icons. Tap an icon to open the selected application or tap Task Manager to open the Task Manager.
