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

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



Orange Loop Current Sensing Your alarm will ignore all current changes for 45 seconds after the alarm is set. Note Professional installers should run a ground wire from the battery to the base of the alarm. The Superbright LED is ON when the system is ARMED and OFF when the system is DISARMED. WARNING! This security system is highly complex in its installation and adjustment procedures.Instructions are NOT provided or enclosed. NOTE Your alarm will ignore all violations; current and shock, for approximately 45 seconds after you arm it. This is a good time to inspect the vehicle for forced entry marks, paint dings or scratches, and check to be sure a wheel isnt partially removed, etc. Adjusting the Shock Sensor NOTE The factory setting on the shock sensor should be acceptable for most vehicles. Tap your hood above the alarm at the sensitivity level you wish. The harder you hit the car the less sensitive the alarm will be. The alarm will then say "Thank You". The shock sensor is now set at this sensitivity. Any shock that is equal to or greater will sound the alarm. Set the sensitivity as often as you wish; however, the sensitivity level will remain set until the battery is disconnected or you reset it. If you do not tap the car it will automatically go to maximum sensitivity. This setting is only acceptable if the car is parked inside a garage. The alarm will chirp 8 times. This is used to locate your vehicle in a crowded parking lot. A woman's voice shouts "Please help me" and alarm sounds for 30 seconds. To stop the alarm before the 30 seconds, press any of the 4 transmitter buttons.

This feature functions at all times; whether the alarm is armed or disarmed, or the engine is off or running. Battery door lock started to open when remote was in packet to the point now is last somewhere and stepping on it by accident easy broke LCD. In order to complete the installation I just taped the key inside. Bulldog wanted me to send the entire Deluxe500B Remote Starter to them. So I figured it best to just purchase a different JBS bypass module, guess what.My key is still secured by electrical tape in the original bypass module. I have installed 3 Bulldog remote starters before but the instructions on this one are the worst that I have seen yet, I think they were translated from french by a chinese person. The bulldog website has instructions for most vehicles but they were incorrect on 2 of my wires. The remote occasionally resets itself as if the battery is disconnecting and you hear that chime that occurs when first installing the battery. The dome light is hooked up correctly because it will flash as it should when hitting the panic button but the horn has never functioned, thats fine though because I dont need any horn confirmations. I think Bulldog has gone down in guality since the other 3 remote starters that I have installed from them, that is probably why the price of this unit has dropped so drastically.
